1. The Art of Leaving No Trace

Our ecosystems—from the coastline and its beaches to national parks and green spaces—are fragile.

- Say goodbye to plastic: Avoid single-use plastics. We encourage you to bring your own water bottle; we'll let you know where you can refill it with safe water.
- Respect for wildlife: Observe animals from a distance. Do not feed or disturb them. Remember: "The best photo is one that does not disturb the animal's behavior."
- Trash-Free Zone: What you bring with you, you take back with you. If you see trash along the way—even if it's not yours—please help us pick it up!



2. A Genuine Connection to Culture

Peru is a living library. To understand it, we suggest:

- Take it from the experts: All our tours are led by local guides. They are the best guides to the area's history and natural environment.
- Ask for permission: Before taking photos of local people or their property, build a rapport and ask. Respect is the foundation of any connection.

Protect the ancient sites: Do not touch the Inca walls or take any natural "souvenirs" (stones, plants, or shells).



3. Social Impact: Your Journey, Their Development

Your presence can transform communities.

- Buy locally and fairly: Choose handmade crafts produced by local artisans. Pay a fair price; excessive haggling affects families' livelihoods.
- Be part of the change: At Suntrace Peru, we work with our stakeholders to promote social initiatives. Ask your guide how you can get involved in our community support initiatives during your stay.



4. Efficiency and Well-being

Every drop counts: In many parts of Peru, water is in short supply. Only take as long a shower as necessary and switch off the lights when you leave your room.

- A healthy body, a happy trip: Stay hydrated, use biodegradable sun cream and choose local, seasonal produce. Your health is key to enjoying the journey.
